1. Why Regular Backpacks Do Not Work for Riding

A standard backpack from a retail store might seem fine for a quick ride to work. But regular bags are simply not built for riding. They lack water resistance, tend to shift and sway at higher speeds, and their straps are not designed for the riding posture. After a few months of daily use, the zippers start to fail, and the stitching begins to loosen.

Motorcycle-specific backpacks solve all of these problems. They are built with weather-resistant shells, padded carry systems designed for riding, and smart

interior layouts with pockets for laptops, wet gear, and everyday items. For anyone riding to work each day, the difference is clear from day one.

2. Key Features to Look for in a Commuter Motorcycle Backpack

Before picking a bag, it is worth knowing which features matter most for the daily commute:

- **Capacity that fits the load:** Most daily riders do well with a bag in the 22L to 32L range. This is large enough to fit a laptop, clothes, and food, while still being easy to carry off the bike. Riders with longer commutes or heavier loads may want to step up to a 45L bag for extra room.
- **Weather resistance:** Riding through rain is part of the deal. Bags made from Cordura, TPU Tarpaulin, or ballistic nylon stand up well against wet weather. An included wet pouch is a solid bonus for keeping damp items away from dry ones inside the bag.
- **A padded laptop sleeve:** For work commuters, this is a must-have. A padded sleeve protects the laptop from road vibration and bumps, and makes it easy to pull out once at the destination.
- **A comfortable carry system:** Padded shoulder straps, an adjustable chest strap, and a hip belt all help spread the pack's weight evenly. This keeps the back and shoulders comfortable on longer rides and during any post-ride walking.
- **Sissy bar mounting compatibility:** Several Viking backpacks come with sissy bar straps, allowing the pack to be fastened directly to the bike when not being worn. This is a great feature for riders who want a cleaner setup while parked.

3. Top Viking Bags Motorcycle Backpacks for Daily Commuting

3.1 32L Viking Trident Large Motorcycle Backpack



The [Viking Trident 32L Large Motorcycle Backpack](#) is a great all-around choice for daily riders. It holds the equivalent of 44 cans of gear, features three front pockets, a top fleece-lined pocket, and a padded 12" x 14" laptop sleeve. One of its most useful features is a separate compartment at the base for shoes, which is perfect for riders who change footwear at the office. Made from Cordura and weather-resistant, it measures 12" x 6.5" x 19.5" and mounts easily to a sissy bar with secure straps.

3.2 30L Viking Tactical Large Motorcycle Backpack



For commuters who value quick access and tidy organization, the Viking 30L Tactical is a smart pick. It opens flat to 180 degrees, making packing and unpacking fast and easy. With a 30-liter capacity (42 cans), a laptop sleeve, two mesh pockets, a sunglasses pouch, and a wet pouch, this pack covers most daily needs. Made from Cordura and weather-resistant, it measures 12" x 11" x 16.75".

3.3 45L Viking Tactical XL Motorcycle Backpack



Riders who haul a heavier load each day will find the Viking Tactical XL to be a top fit. At 45 liters, it holds up to 63 cans worth of gear and fits two 25-oz water bottles inside. It opens flat to 180 degrees and includes a 12" x 14" laptop sleeve, a sunglasses pouch, a wet pouch, and two mesh pockets. Measuring 15" x 11" x 19", this is the go-to option for long commutes or heavier packing needs.

3.4 30L Viking Voyage Large Motorcycle Backpack



The Viking Voyage brings a rigid-shell build to the lineup. At 30 liters, it holds 42 cans of gear and includes a 13" x 7.5" laptop sleeve. The wide 18" x 14" lid opening makes loading and unloading quick and effortless. Measuring 18" x 11.5" x 18", the Voyage is a strong choice for commuters who want their gear well-protected and neatly sorted.

3.5 32L Viking Renegade Motorcycle Dry Backpack



Built for riders who ride in all kinds of weather, the Viking Renegade features two water-resistant zippered compartments and external webbing for attaching extra gear. At 32 liters (44 cans), it measures 11.5" x 11.5" x 19" and comes with a solid shoulder strap system. It is a no-fuss, tough option for daily riding in wet or dry conditions.

3.6 22L Viking Explorer Adventure Touring Backpack



Made from TPU Tarpaulin, the Viking Explorer 22L is a lightweight and weather-resistant pick for urban riders. It features a MOLLE attachment system, an adjustable chest strap, a removable hip belt, and front tie-down straps for compression. At 22 liters (30 cans), it is easy to carry around once off the bike, with a compact profile that works well in city traffic. Dimensions are 15" x 5.7" x 27".

3.7 12L Viking Explorer Adventure Touring Backpack with Chest Harness



For minimalist commuters, the Viking 12L Explorer is a slim but capable pack. It comes with a 2.0L hydration pack with an insulated hose, a MOLLE panel, multiple pockets, and a satellite phone holder built into the shoulder straps. Made from ballistic nylon, it measures 9.5" x 4" x 18.25" and is ideal for short city rides where a full-size bag is not needed.

4. How to Choose the Right Size for the Daily Ride

- **Light commuters** who carry a slim device and a few small items will do well with the 12L or 22L Explorer options from Viking.
- **Mid-range commuters** bringing a full laptop, clothes, and lunch should go with the 30L to 32L range for a well-balanced fit.
- **Heavy-load commuters** or riders with longer daily trips should opt for the 45L Viking Tactical XL for the extra capacity.

5. Tips for Riding Daily with a Motorcycle Backpack

- Always clip the chest strap before hitting higher speeds. It keeps the pack locked in place and cuts down on wind drag at the back.
- Place heavier items close to the back panel to keep the load centered and reduce fatigue over longer rides.
- Use the wet pouch or dry compartments to keep rain gear and sweaty items separate from clean work clothes and tech.
- When stopping for the day, use the sissy bar straps to mount the pack to the bike. This keeps it safe and frees up the rider to walk around without wearing the bag.
